Aim

The course aims to provide participants with knowledge and skill development to perform the manufacture of free-standing furniture or built-in cabinets, and provide on-site assistance in the installation of furniture or cabinets involving known routines and procedures

Credit towards VCE /VCE VM:	<p>Students who undertake the VCE VET Furnishing program based on qualifications from the MSF Furnishing Training package may be eligible for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The award of MSF20516 Certificate II in Furniture Making • Recognition of up to four units at Units 1 and 2 level and a Units 3 and 4 sequence.
ATAR contribution:	<p>Students wishing to receive an ATAR contribution for the Units 3 and 4 sequence of VCE VET Furnishing must undertake scored assessment for the purpose of achieving a study score. This study score can contribute directly to the ATAR, either as one of the student's best four studies (the primary four) or as a fifth or sixth study.</p> <p>Where a student elects not to receive a study score for VCE VET Furnishing, no contribution to the ATAR will be available.</p>
Cost:	Students need to check with their home school regarding cost of course and required resource costs.
VCE VM:	This program is suitable for the industry skills component of a VCE-VM course.

A student who successfully completes MSF20516 Certificate II in Furniture Making may obtain employment as an assistant cabinet maker, assistant installer of built-in cabinets, or production operator within a cabinet making enterprise
