

RECOGNITION

Credit in the VCE

Students who complete AUR20720 CERTIFICATE II in AUTOMOTIVE - Vocational Preparation will be eligible for four units of credit towards their VCE: two units at Units 1 and 2, and a Units 3 and 4 sequence.

ATAR Contribution

Students who receive a Units 3 and 4 sequence for AUR20720 CERTIFICATE II in AUTOMOTIVE - Vocational Preparation or any of the approved school-based apprenticeship and traineeship qualifications from the Automotive industry area will be eligible for an increment towards their ATAR (10% of the average of the primary four scaled studies).

Students interested in the contribution of the ATAR score to their VCE should speak to their Careers Counsellor.

VCE-VM

This program is suitable for the industry skills component of a VCE-VM course.

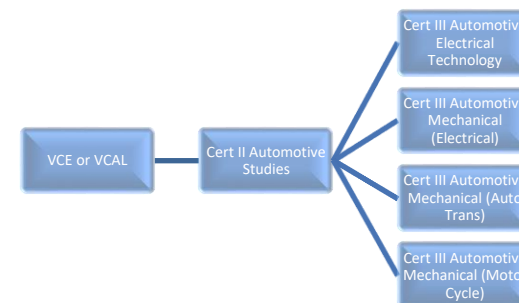
